



The Principle of Strict Liability

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According to article 2.1.1 of the Code: Each athlete is personally responsible for ensuring that no Prohibited Substance appears in their system. Athletes will be responsible for the presence of any Prohibited Substance, its Metabolites or its Markers that are detected in their samples.

Therefore, it will not be necessary to demonstrate intent, guilt, negligence or conscious use on the part of the athlete to determine that an anti-doping rule violation has occurred in accordance with the provisions of Article 2.1.
